- Respect your Team, Club and League officials. Always accept the referee's and their assistants' decisions. Be gracious in victory or defeat.

- Be self-controlled and courteous. Do not argue with the officials, supporters or other players.
- Do not act in an aggressive manner or use bad language.
- Listen and learn – follow instructions. Do not talk when the coach is talking.
- Encourage each other and always be supportive.
- Keep good time – arrive early for training sessions and matches. Advise your coach in advance if you will be absent or late.
- Watch and support your team and club, even when not playing.
- Enjoy yourselves, work hard, always try your best and always show a positive attitude.

Always wear your Bartley Reds Football Club shirt with pride, honour and passion.

Parents/ Spectators must:

- Be positive and encouraging towards ALL children. Remember, this is for fun!
- Never criticise players. Avoid coaching/ giving instructions.
- Applaud both teams for good play.
- Never enter the pitch.
- Respect the referee and their decisions.
